Case Definition of SApIW

Inclusive criteria

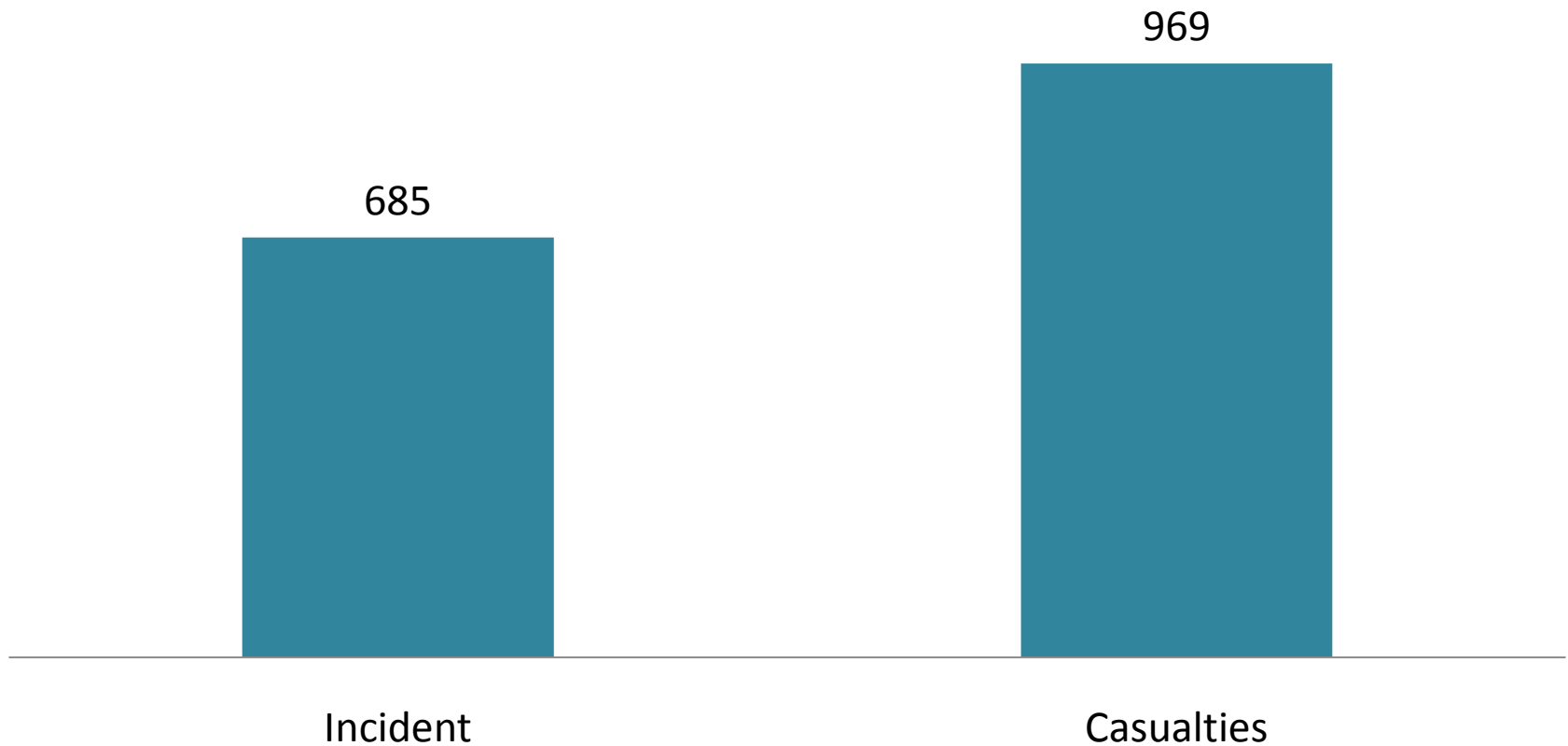
- Casualties injured or killed in Nepal since 1 November 2009 by SApIW.
- Small Arms are Firearms
- Other portable lethal weapons:
 - Sharp weapons (knives, swords, khukuris, bamboo sticks, axe, and rod ...).
 - Improvised Explosive Devices (IEDs) and Other explosive devices – used intentionally.

Exclusive Criteria

- Casualties of victim-activated explosions
- Casualties with minor physical injuries (not needing medical treatment and follow up)



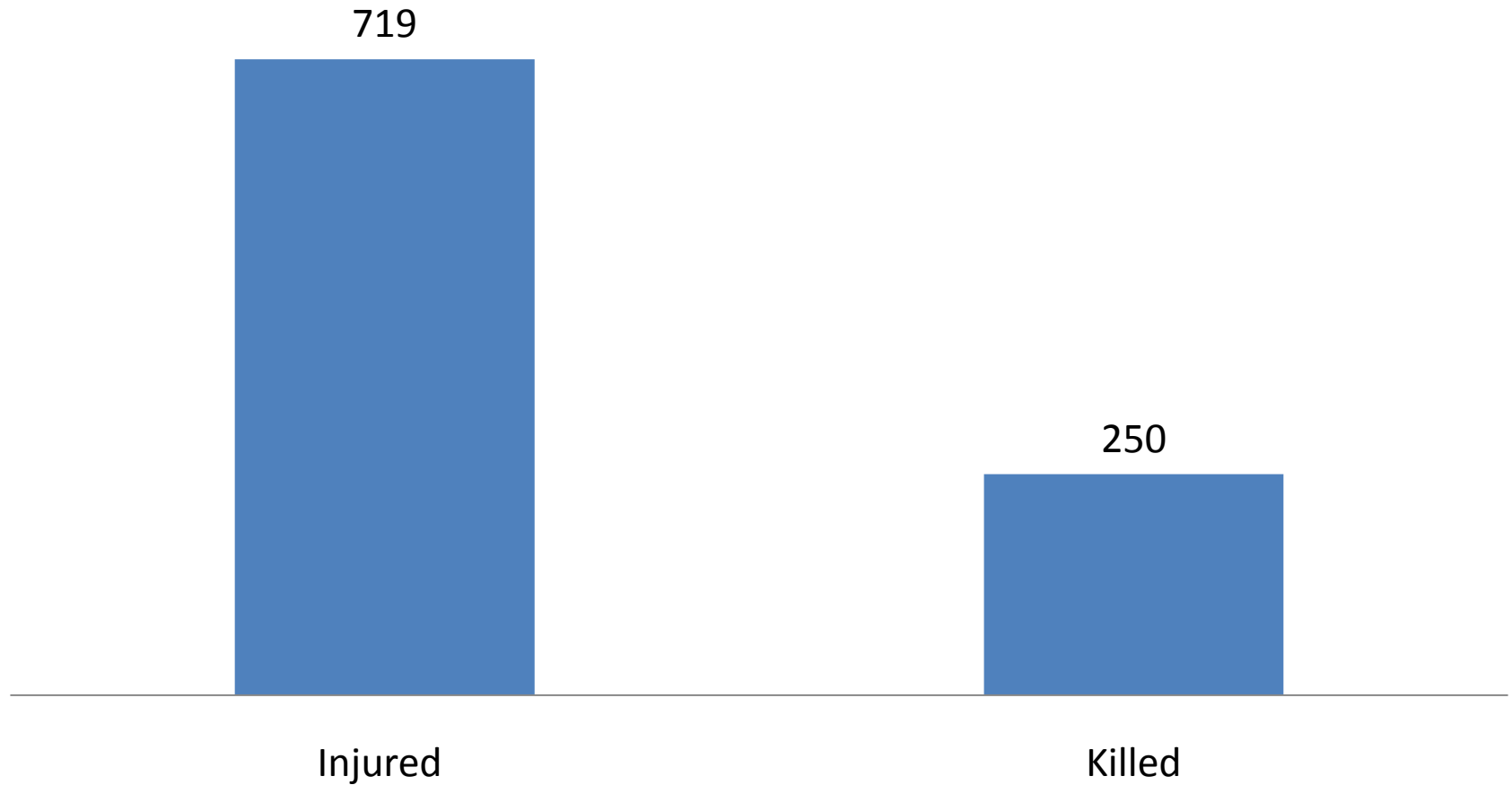
Number of Incidents and Casualties January 2010 - May 2011





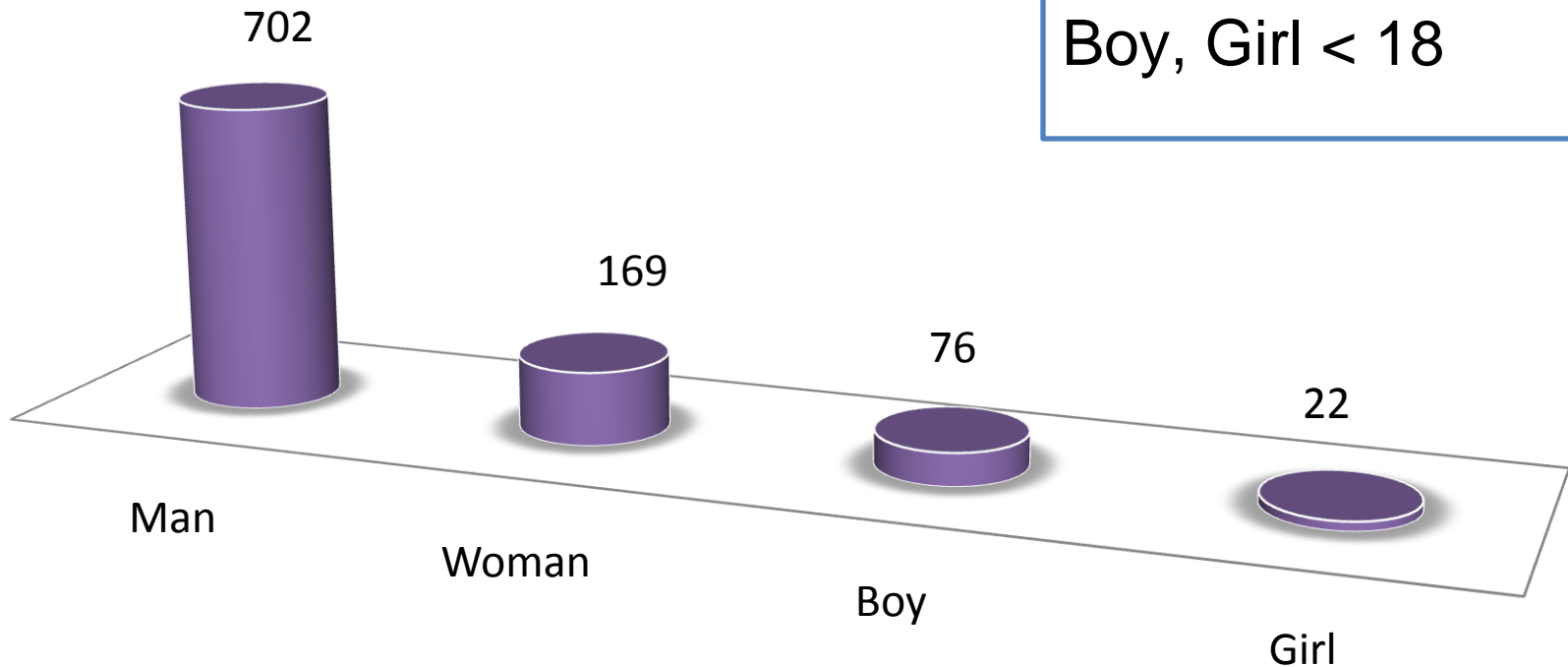
Death Ratio

January 2010- May 2011



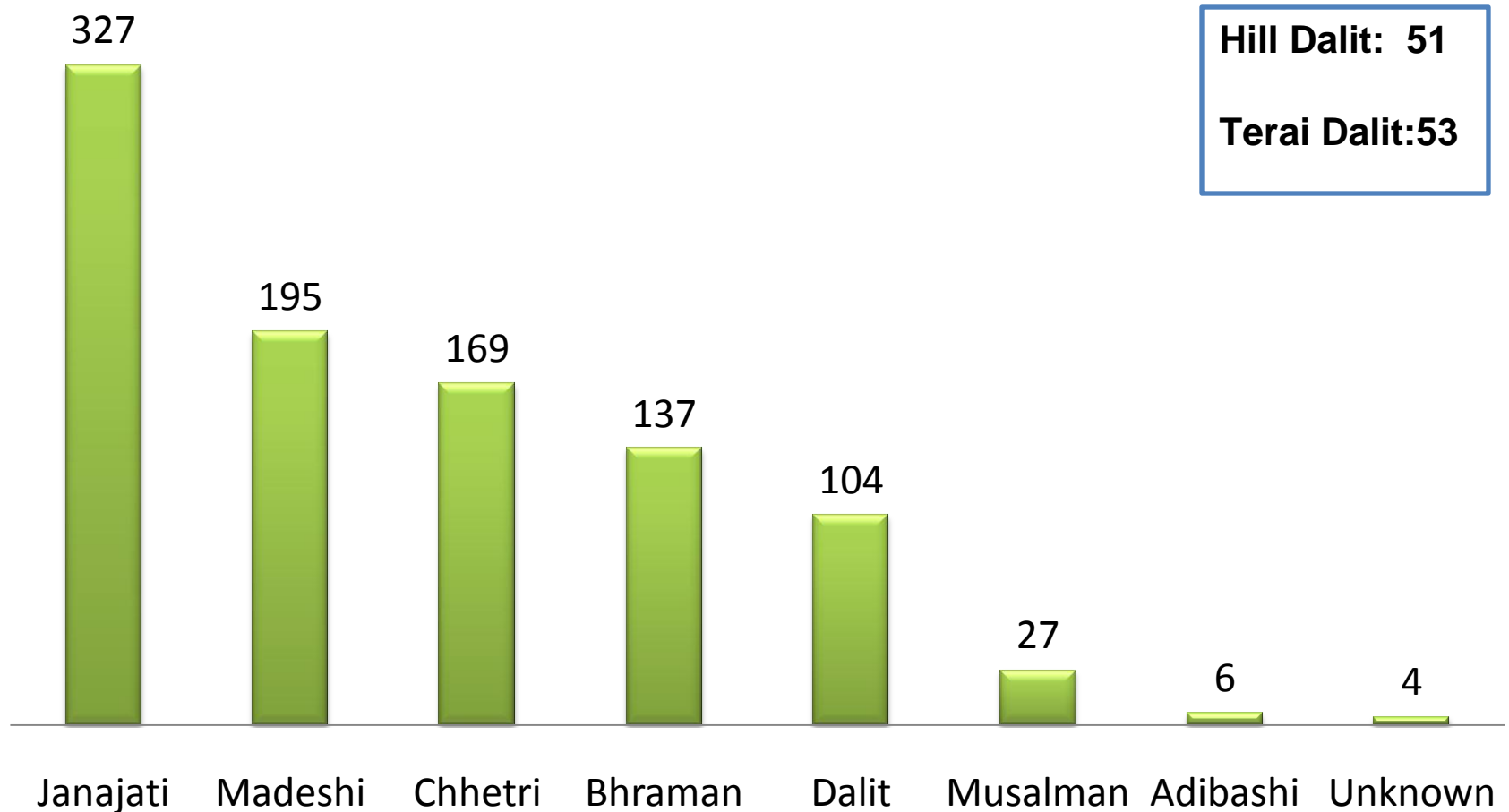
Casualties by Age and Sex January 2010 - May 2011

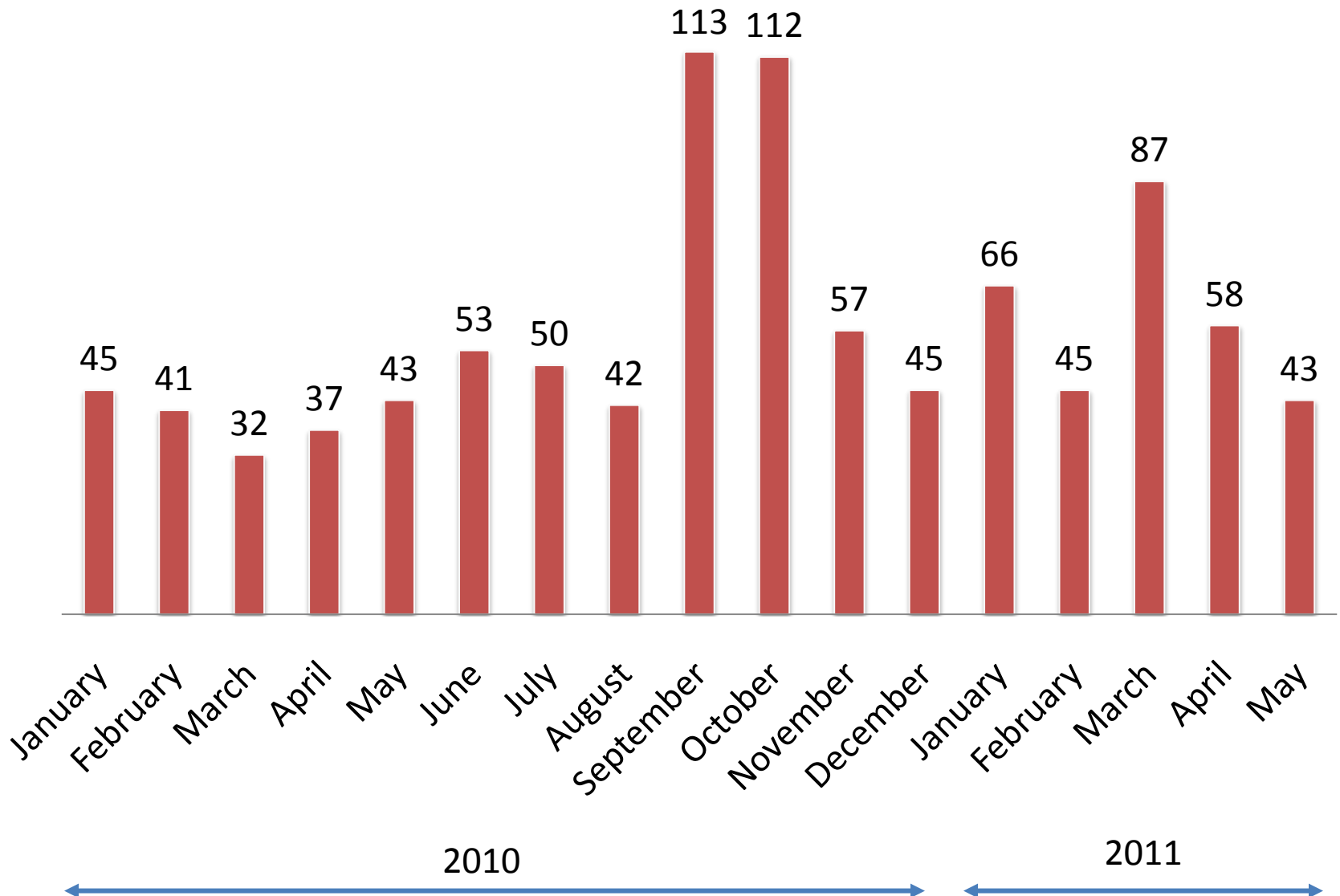

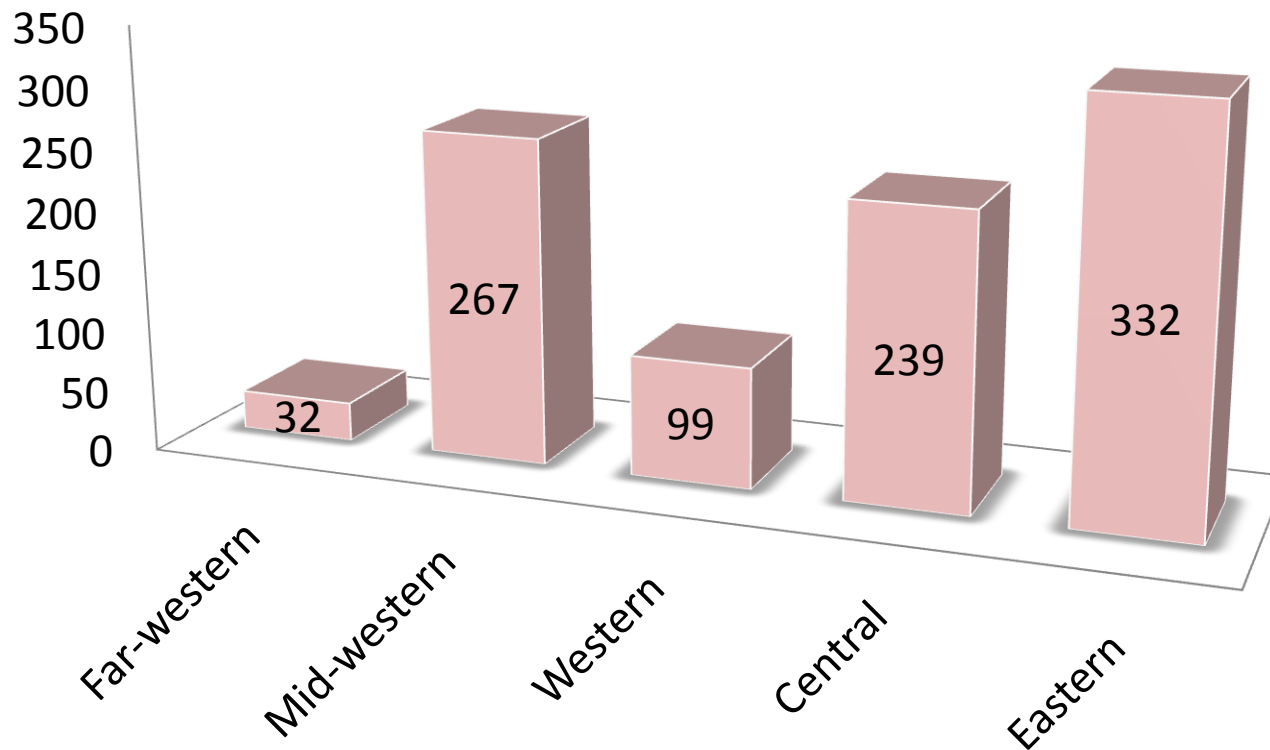
Casualties by Month

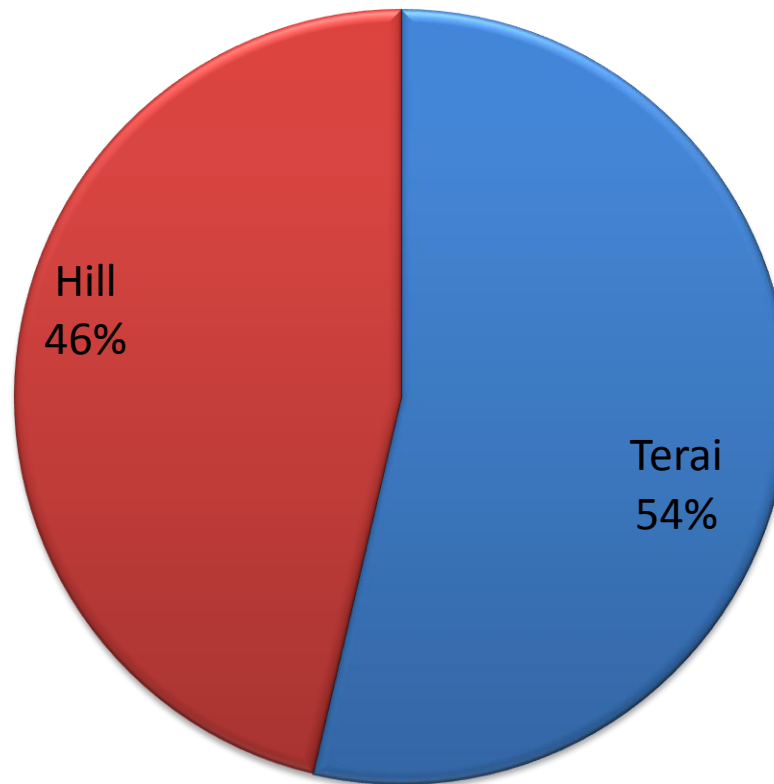

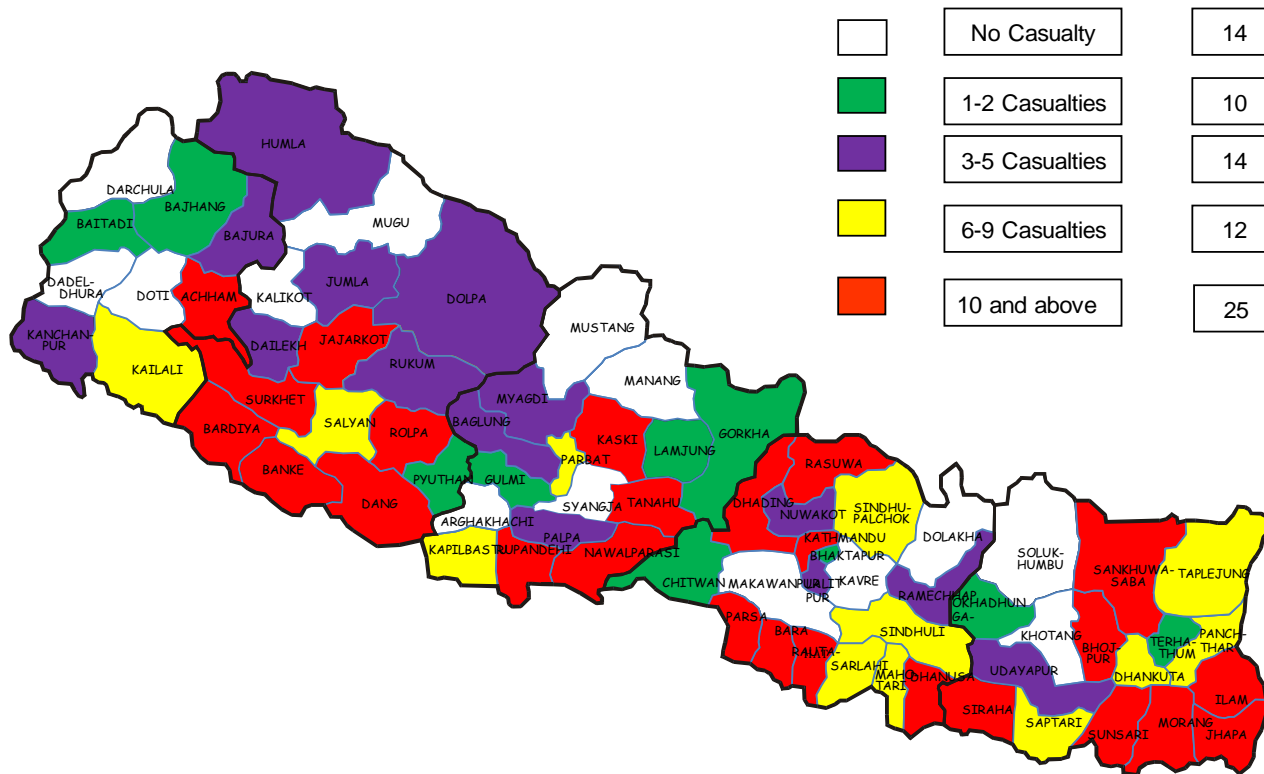
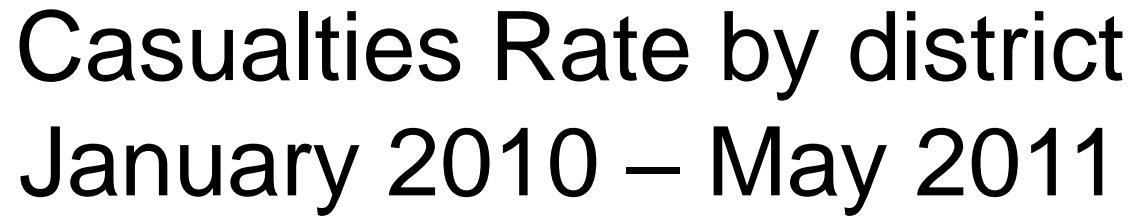




Casualties by Ecological Belt

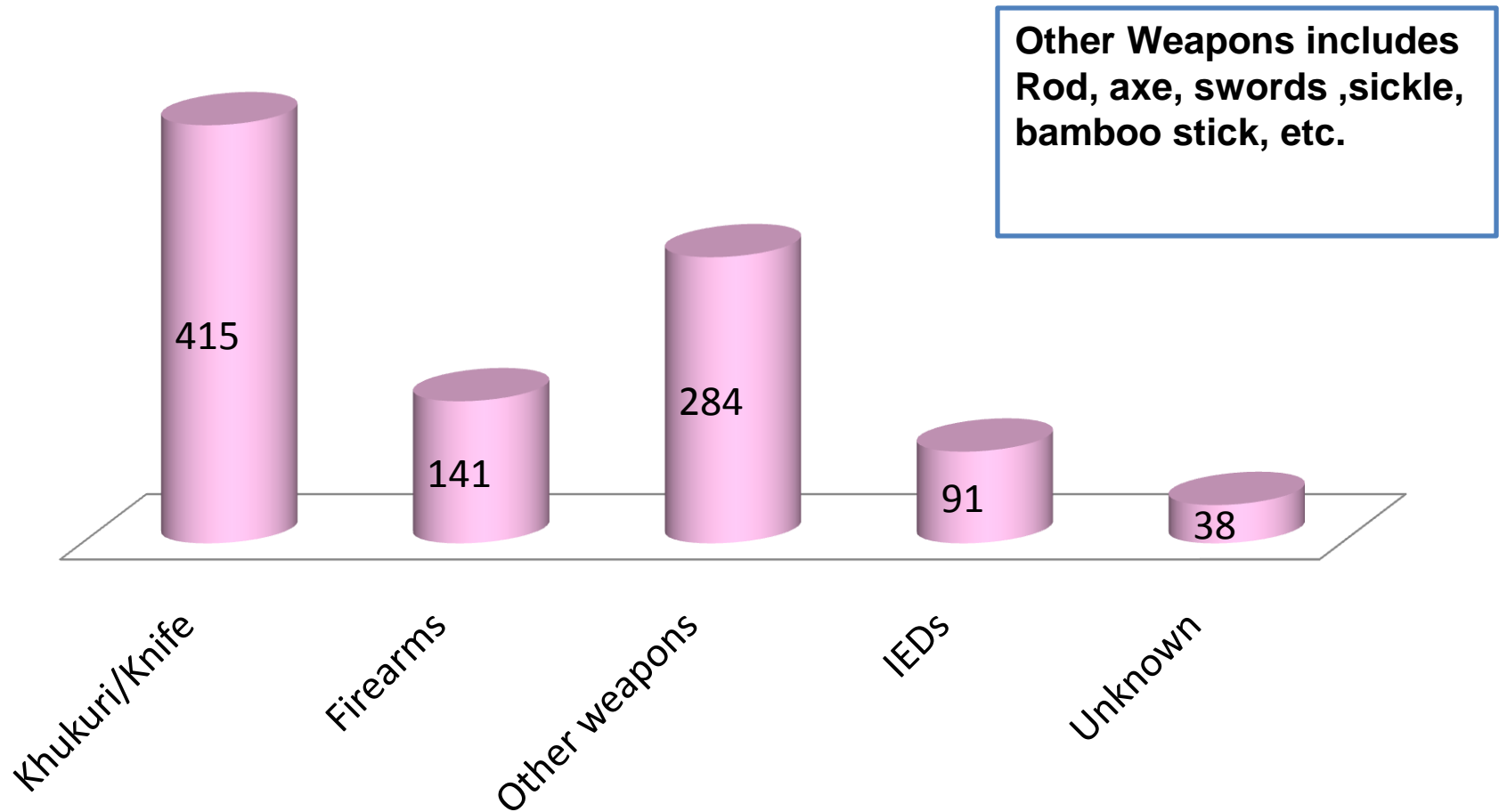

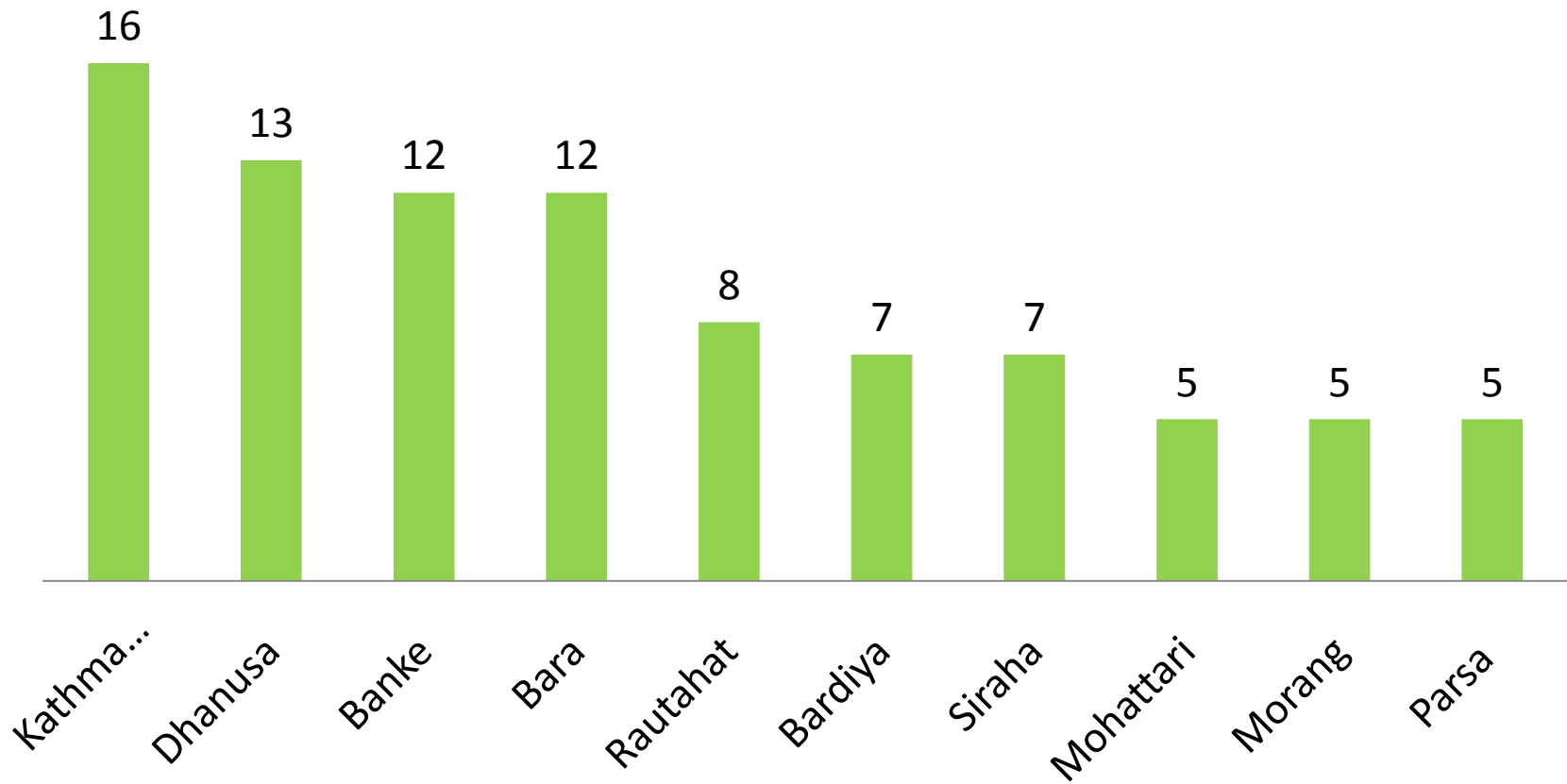


Types of Weapons Causing Casualties January 2010 - May 2011



Firearms Casualties by most affected 10 Districts

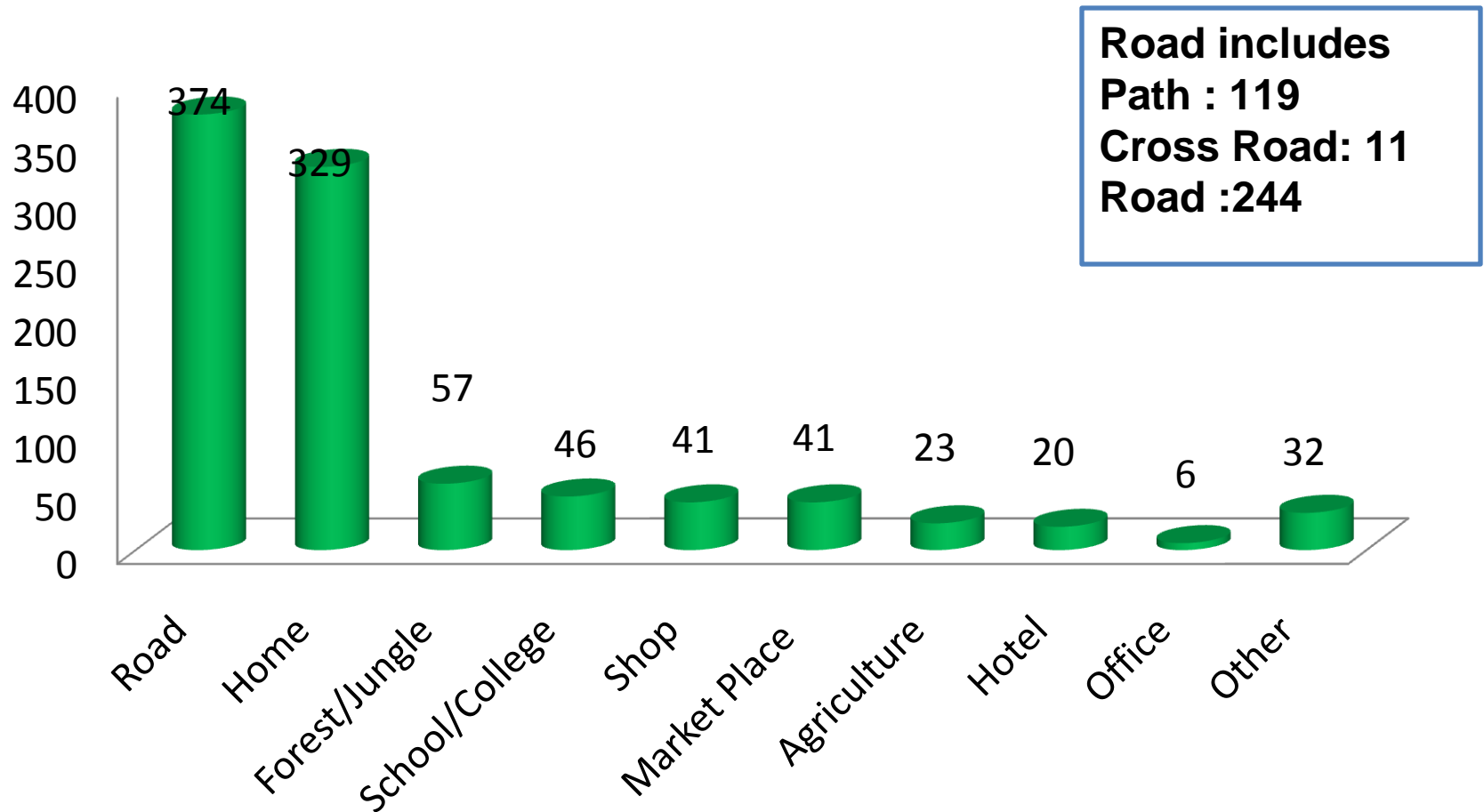

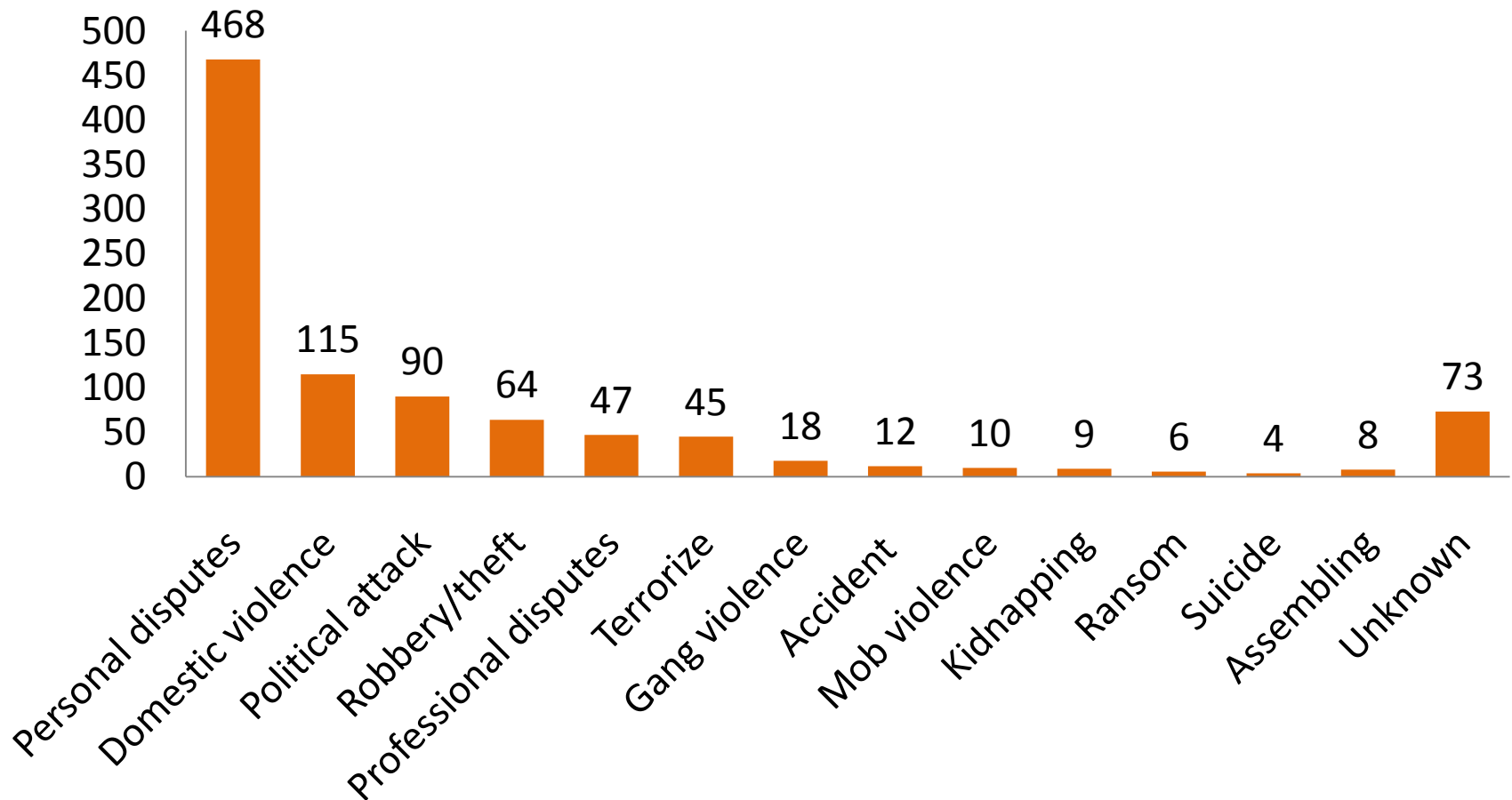

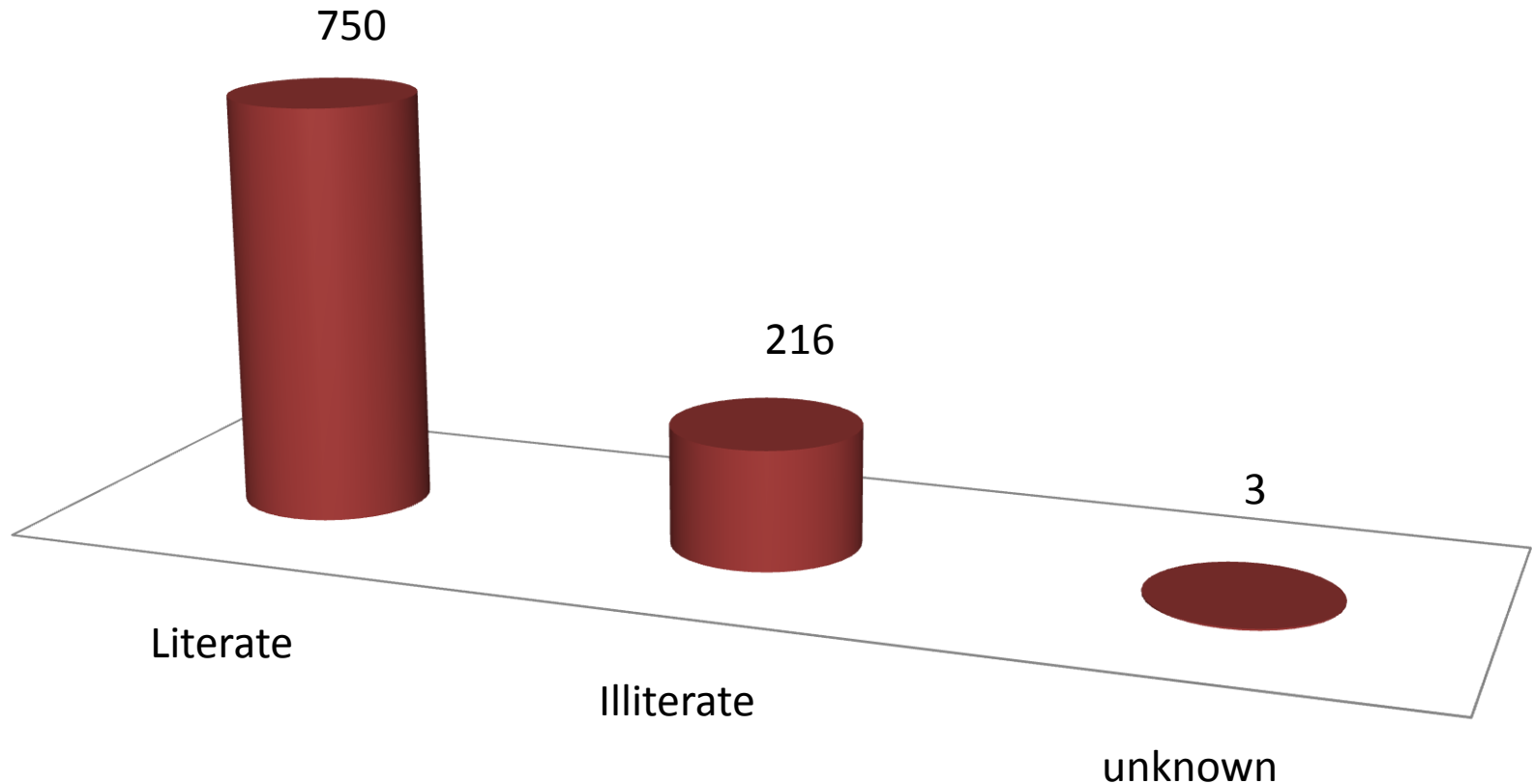

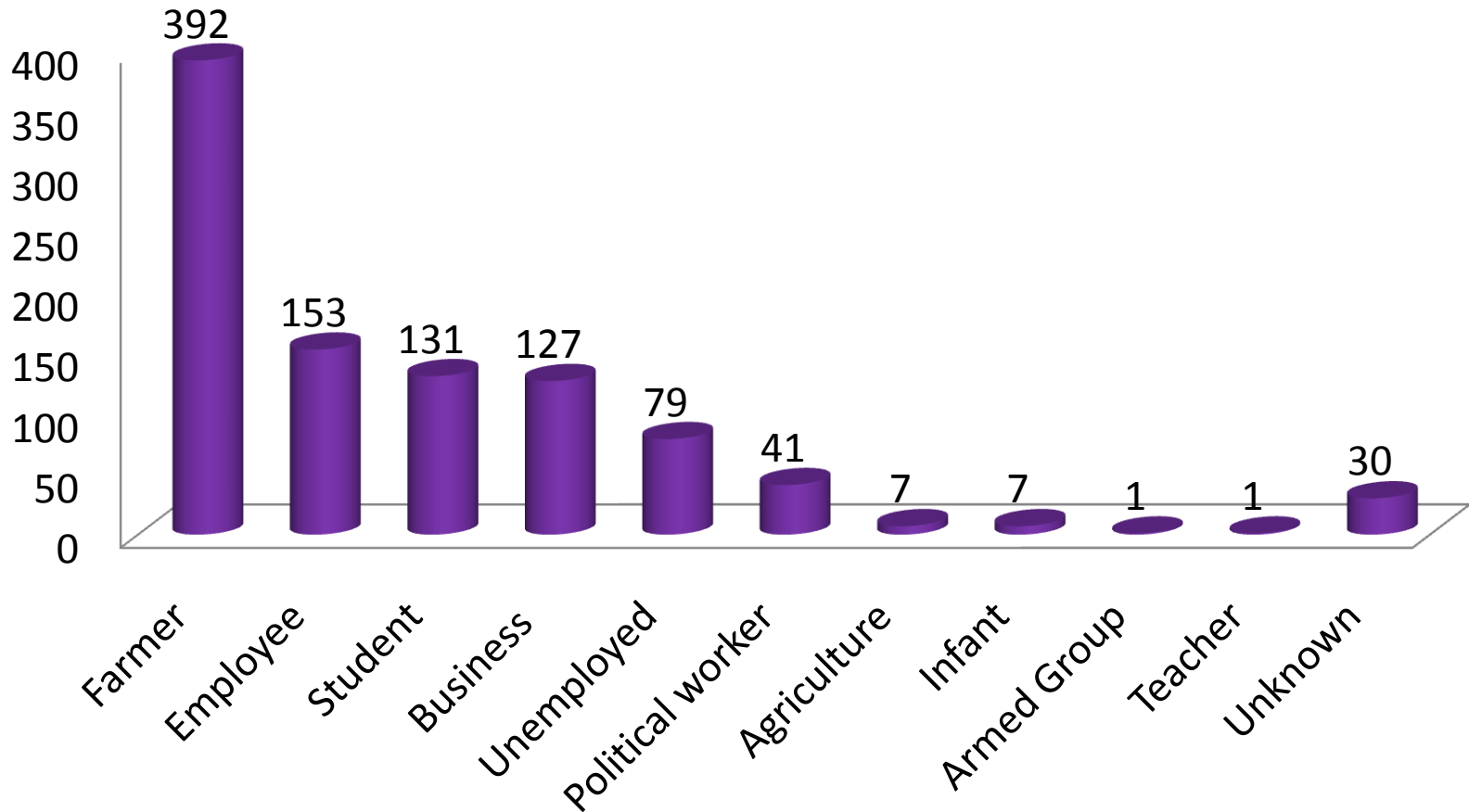
Casualties by Education Status January 2010 - May 2011

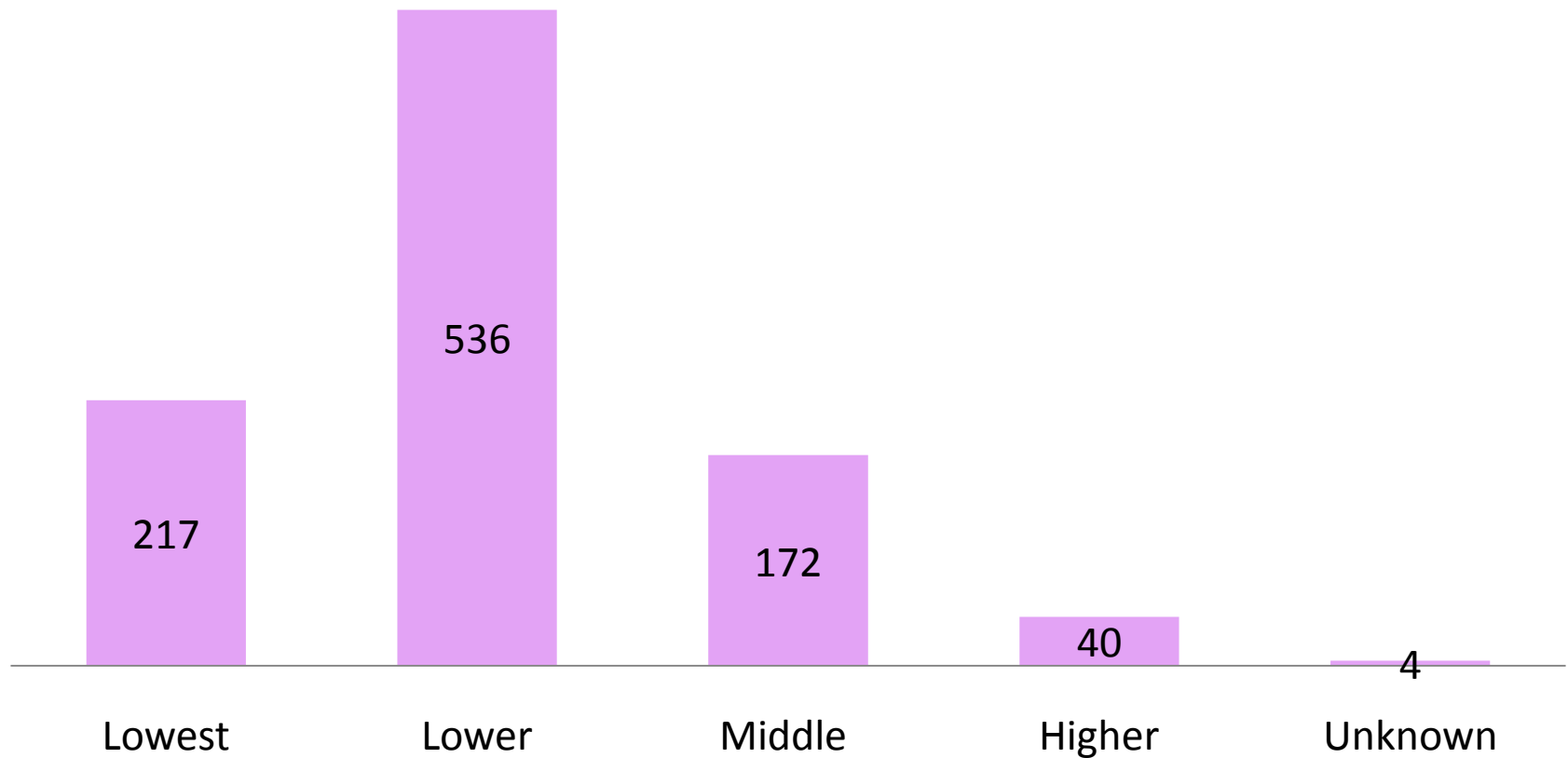

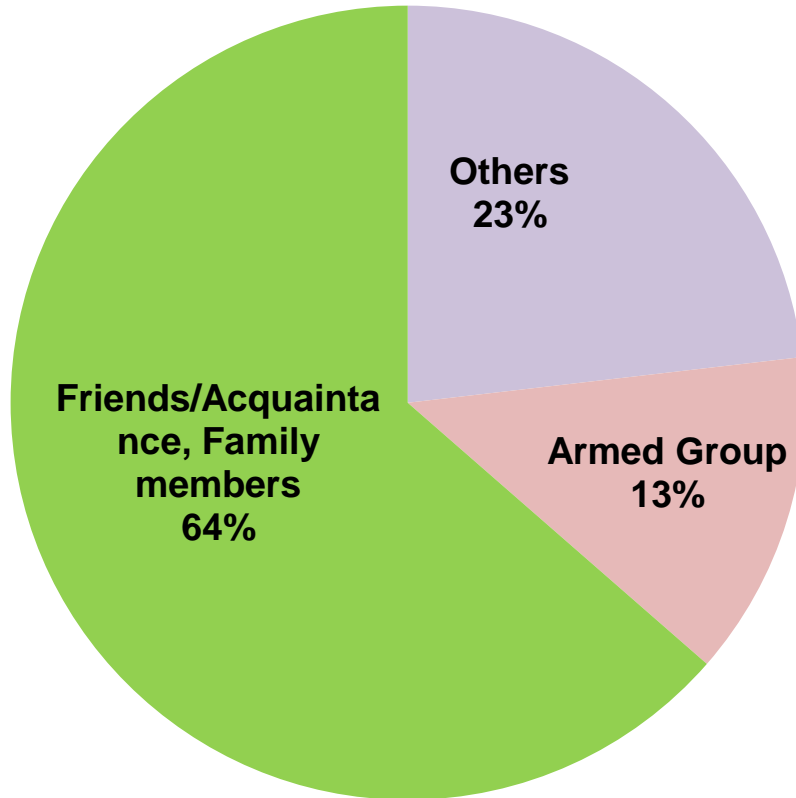




Casualties by Perpetrator

Total Casualties: 626

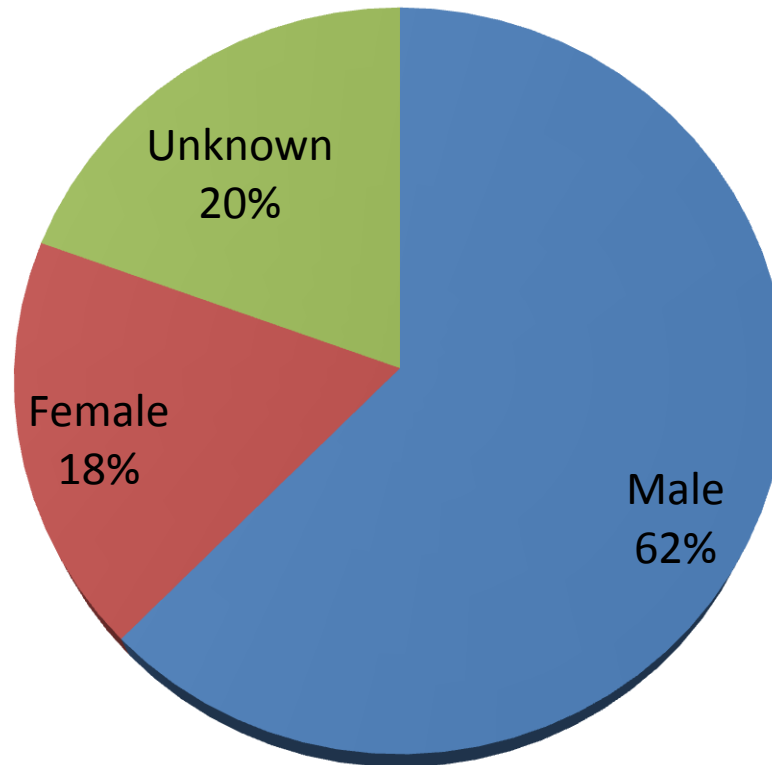

September 2010 - May 2011

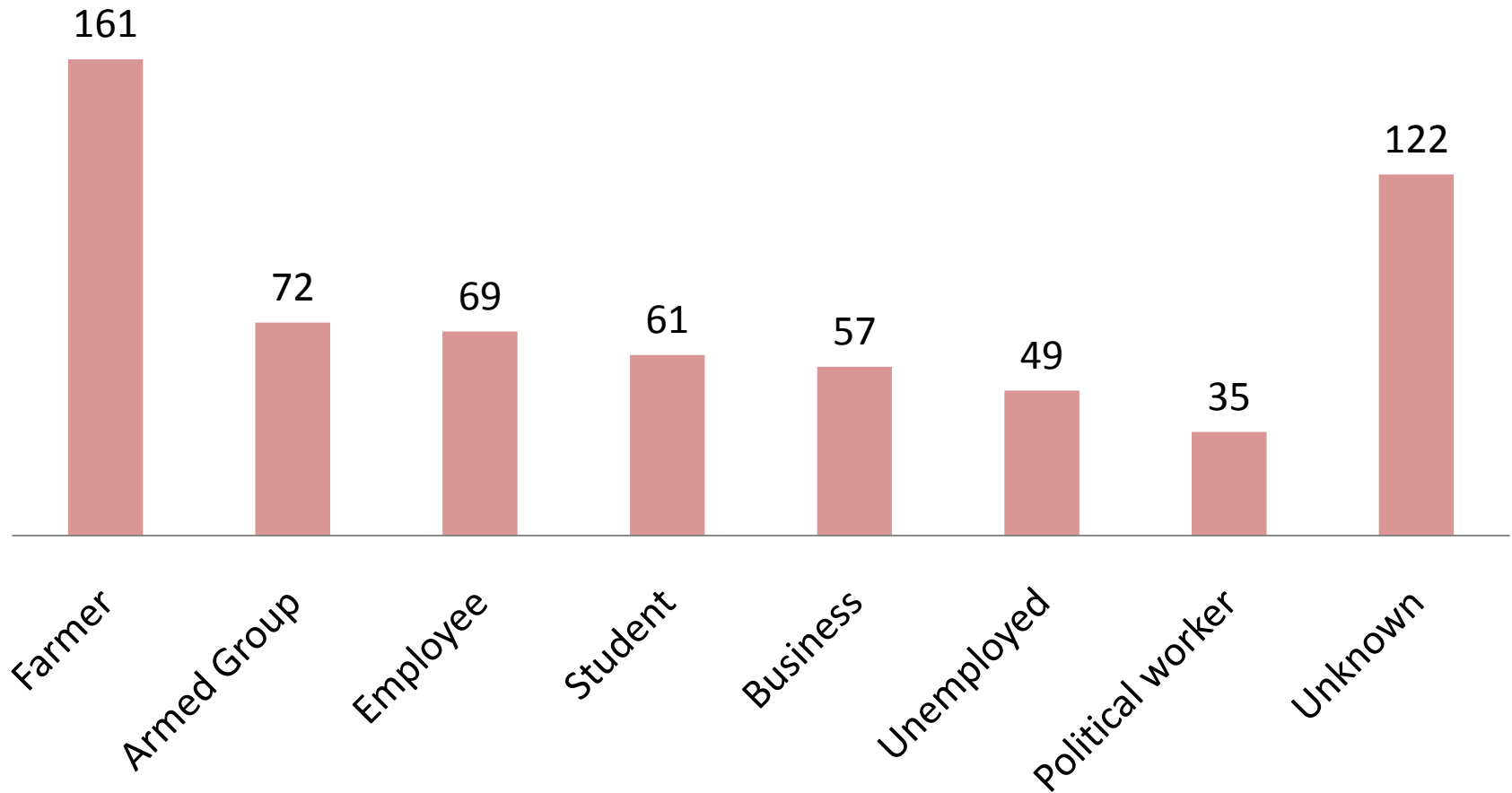

Things to be noted

- Almost 1000 casualties with 685 incidents in past 17 months
- 719 people were injured and 250 people were killed
- Majority of the victims were male (80%)
- Morang, Surkhet and Banke are the three most affected districts
- 374 (39%) were affected by the incidents that took place at road, path and cross road followed by 329 (34%) who were affected by incident that took place at home.
- Personal dispute (468) was the main cause of casualties followed by domestic violence (115)
- Majority of the perpetrator were friends, acquaintance and family members (64%)
